

## ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

In order to provide a systematic means for interpreting and implementing policies and legal mandates, appropriate administrative regulations and procedures shall be formulated and maintained. These regulations should prescribe in necessary detail the procedures by which a course of action is to be accomplished.

The initiation and development of regulations and procedures shall be the responsibility of the superintendent, who shall make provisions for appropriate staff involvement.

The Board reserves the right to review and veto administrative rules should they, in the Board's judgment, be inconsistent with the policies adopted by the Board.
