

## EVALUATION OF INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMS

As a part of the continuing effort to evaluate the educational system, appropriate means for curriculum evaluation shall be established and maintained.

It shall be the responsibility of the superintendent to periodically inform the Board of Education on the progress that is being made toward the attainment of its educational goals.

It shall also be the intent of the Board to keep the public informed about school needs and about actual results being obtained from the public's support of school programs.
