

INTRADISTRICT TRANSFERS
(Transfers Due to Redistricting in 2012-2014)

The following will apply to any transfers effective in the 2012-13 and 2013-14 school years due to redistricting. Students will attend the school in their assigned attendance areas unless otherwise required by law; the superintendent or designee has assigned the student to a different school; a voluntary transfer as described in Board policy has been approved; or one of the exceptions listed below applies.

1. Students who are in ninth grade in 2011-12 who are assigned to attend Rock Bridge or Hickman High Schools beginning in 2013-14 may transfer to their newly assigned high school for their 2012-13 school year if they notify the district in writing by May 1, 2012. Students who do not request to transfer by that date will go to their assigned high school in the 2013-14 school year. Students who choose to transfer to their assigned high school early will be provided transportation.
2. If in the 2013-14 school year a freshman, sophomore or junior student has a sibling who is a senior attending Rock Bridge or Hickman High Schools, the student or parent may request a transfer to the same high school the senior sibling attends. The district will attempt to accommodate these transfers, subject to available space and relevant educational considerations as determined by the district. The request must be received by the district in writing by May 1, 2012. Transportation will be provided to these students for the 2013-14 school year only.

Transportation will not be provided to students transferring to a school outside the student's attendance area unless otherwise provided for as outlined above.
