

Non-A+ Colleges/Universities Offering A+ Incentives

PLEASE NOTE: The list of benefits below are NOT exhaustive NOR are they regularly updated and therefore may/may not be accurate at the time this document is being accessed. Check with the admissions office of the college/university to ask directly if their institution offers scholarships/stipends for students with A+ student certification.

Avila University	Yes! \$1,000 scholarship, renewable all 4 years, in addition to any other academic scholarship the student qualifies for.
Central Methodist University	Yes! 50% reduction on tuition. Renewable 4 years, with cum GPA of 2.5. Also applies to academically qualified college students who earn an associate's degree at a public institution under the A+ program and transfer to CMU to complete a four-year degree.
College of the Ozarks	NO
Columbia College	Yes! Students who qualify for the A+ program that transfer in with an associate's degree or 60 hours with a 3.0 cumulative college GPA will receive a renewable 1/3 tuition scholarship . Must have attended community college on an A+ grant.
Cox College of Nursing	NO
Culver-Stockton College	Yes! \$1,500 in addition to any other scholarship.
Drury University	Yes! First-year freshmen may apply for a \$1,000 renewable scholarship (renewable with a 3.0 or higher GPA). Students receiving athletic scholarships are not eligible. On-line application required.
Evangel University	Yes! \$1,000 scholarship, renewable. Requires application, 3.0 GPA and proof of A+ completion.
Fontbonne University	Yes! May be eligible for \$1,000 per year in additional scholarship funds. Also A+ graduates who have completed or will complete their AA, AAS or AS from any public Missouri community college and have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0. Award ranges from \$4,500 to \$6,500 per academic year.
Hannibal-LaGrange	Yes! Offers a \$3,000 academic scholarship which cannot be combined with other academic scholarships.
Harris-Stowe University	NO
Kansas City Art Institute	Yes! Offers \$1,000 per year for four years for A+ Scholarship.
Lincoln University	NO
Lindenwood University	Yes! For graduates from St. Charles County and other neighboring counties who have significant community service and at least a 21 on the ACT. Student will participate in Lindenwood's Work and Learn Program. Application required.
Maryville University	NO
Merrell University of Beauty Arts	NO
Mid America Nazarene University (Kansas)	Yes! \$2,000 scholarship each year for freshman and sophomore years.
Missouri Baptist University	NO but they do take A+ eligibility in to consideration when awarding university scholarships.
Missouri University of Science & Technology	NO
Missouri Southern State University	Yes! A+ Leadership Scholarship. Total of 100 per year on first-come, first served basis. \$500 per semester for a max of 8 semesters. Cannot be combined with other academic awards. Application required.
Missouri State University	Westplains Campus only--full A+ benefits. Springfield Campus--NO
Missouri Valley College	Yes! Half tuition.
Missouri Western	Yes! \$1,500 scholarship which can be combined with other academic awards.. Application and 3.0 cumulative GPA required. We also can offer A+ funds to students going in to our associate degree programs (legal assistant, manufacturing engineering technology, criminal justice and physical therapy assistant) .

Northwest Missouri State	Yes! \$1,500, renewable for an additional year if you meet the criteria. May combine with other Northwest scholarships. Students accepted into the Enhanced Freshman Seminar are NOT eligible for the A+ scholarship. Must indicate A+ on admissions application and be accepted by April 1.
Park University	Yes! 50% of tuition scholarship, 3.25 cumulative high school GPA OR 24 ACT/1650 SAT score.
Rockhurst University	NO but transfer scholarships are available.
Saint Louis University	NO but transfer scholarships are available.
Southeast Missouri State	Yes! Incidental and general fees for courses that are part of an eligible program – Automated Manufacturing, Microcomputer Systems, Technical Computer, and Assoc. of Arts/Child Care and Guidance. Approx. \$6,500 per year.
Southwest Baptist University	NO
Stephens College	Yes! \$1,000 a year.
Truman State University	Yes! \$500 per year for A+ eligible students. Students must have a 3.25 or higher GPA and 23+ ACT. This scholarship is limited.
University of Central Missouri	NO

Washington University	NO
Webster University	Yes! \$1,000 -2,000 per year for A+ eligible students, based on cum GPA and ACT/SAT score. Students must have a 21+ ACT or 1500+ SAT. Can be used in addition to any academic scholarship. Application due by Mar. 1.
Westminster College	NO but they do take A+ eligibility in to consideration when awarding university scholarships.
William Jewell College	NO
William Woods University	Yes! \$1,000 a year, renewable. Can be combined with other scholarships.
