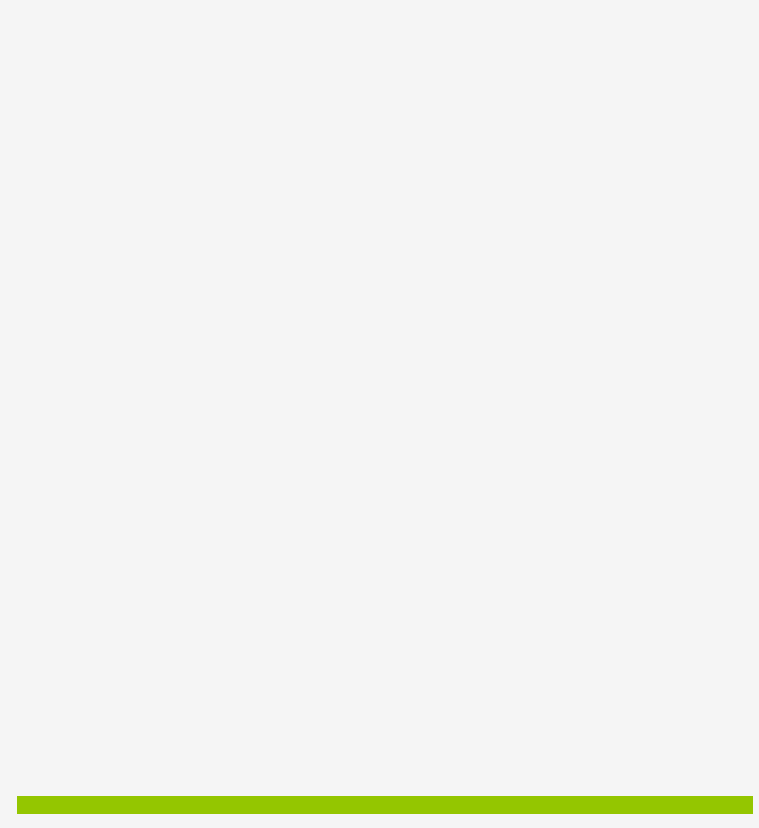

You can apply to Columbia College via the web. Applications submitted electronically receive the same consideration as the applications submitted on paper.

The Columbia College application is part of the ApplyYourself Application Network. If you already have a PIN, you can use it to access our application. If you do not, create a new account here and you will receive a PIN and password so that you can return to work on your application at any time prior to its submission. Your information is transmitted through a secure server and will be kept confidential. Only after you submit your completed application will it be reviewed by our admissions staff.

When you have completed your application and are ready to submit it, you can pay your application fee via credit card online, electronic check or you can mail a check or money order to your campus. No application will be processed until the application fee is paid.

Please carefully read the instructions that appear throughout the application pages. You can only submit your application **one** time. To update any information you have submitted, please contact your campus for assistance.

Automatic Awards

- Cornerstone Scholarship: \$2,000
 - Criteria: 3.2 GPA and 24 ACT/1110 SAT
 - Renewable: 3.0 GPA and 27 CC semester hours
- Keystone Scholarship: Half Tuition
 - Criteria: 3.4 GPA and 26 ACT/1190 SAT
 - Renewable: 3.2 GPA and 27 CC semester hours
- Capstone Scholarship: Half Tuition + \$2,000
 - Criteria: 3.75 GPA and 28 ACT/1260 SAT
 - Renewable: 3.4 Cum GPA and 27 CC semester hours

Automatic Awards

- Alumni Legacy Scholarship: 20% discount
 - Criteria: **Children** of alumni, 3.5 GPA and 26 ACT
 - Renewable: 3.3 Cum GPA and 27 semester hours
- Alumni Legacy Grant: 10-15% discount
 - Criteria: **Children or grandchildren** of alumni
 - Children of alumni = 15%
 - Grandchildren of alumni = 10%
 - Renewable: Good academic standing

Automatic Awards

- Disciples of Christ Award: \$1,000
 - Criteria: Pastors recommendation
 - Renewable: 2.5 cum GPA
- Disciples of Christ Schiffman Supplementary Award: \$1,000
 - Criteria: Pastors recommendation
 - Renewable: 2.5 cum GPA
- Valedictorian/Salutatorian Award: \$1,000
 - Criteria: First or Second in class
 - Nonrenewable

Automatic Awards

- Midwest Student Exchange: 10% discount
 - Criteria: Permanent address in Kansas, Indiana, Michigan, Minnesota, Nebraska, North Dakota, Wisconsin or Illinois
 - Renewable: Good academic standing
- ROTC: Room
 - Criteria: ROTC Contract
- Two-in-Family: \$500
 - Criteria: Two members of family enrolled full-time
 - Renewable: Good academic standing

Competitive Awards

- Scholarship Days
 - Columbia College Scholarship – Full Tuition, Room and Board
 - Renewable: 3.6 GPA and 27 semester hours
 - Presidential Scholarship – Full Tuition
 - Renewable: 3.6 GPA and 27 semester hours
- Phi Theta Kappa Honor Scholarship
 - Renewable: 3.5 GPA and 27 semester hours

 - Art: Portfolio of artwork
